

*Summary of the most significant services carried out by the club
during the previous years (up to 30/6/2018)*

Membership

- 2017/2018* We were 33 members at 1 July 2017 and we are as many as 1 July 2018. We lost 2 of them (1 of which became an honorary member) and we acquired the same number (a former member returned to the club and a 34-year-old gallerist and expert modern and contemporary art "). The will of growing up remains in the club but it is not easy. In the PAF we had 3 people who were following us with good prospects, but for various reasons (including health) they dissolved We reiterate that we are aware that the ability of a club to serve the community, to support the Rotary Foundation and to provide executives who serve Rotary, at the district and international level, depends on the number and harmony of their members.
- 2016/2017* We were 31 members on July 1st 2016; a new member jointed in October 2016 transferred from RC Bosa. A further member arrived in April 2017 bringing a breath of youth. Today we are in 33. In the club there is a will to grow and rejuvenate; in PAF we have 3/4 aspiring members who are following the club's activity with some good prospects. We know perfectly that the club's capacity to assist the community, to sustain the Rotary Foundation and to prepare persons able to take responsibilities inside Rotary, at district and international level, depends on the number and the closeness of the members
- 2015/2016* We were 35 members on July 1st 2015; one new member joined in March 2016, unfortunately one died in May and at the end of the year 3 resigned for various reasons and one was dismissed. Today we are 31. We were not able to grow.
- 2014/2015* We were 40 members on July 1st 2014; during this year 3 new jointed the club and 8 left. Today, July 1st 2015 we are 35. We know perfectly that the capacity of a club to serve the community, to sustain the Rotary Foundation and to form Rotary leaders, at district and international level, depends on the number and the affinity between the members. Therefore we must improve on this point.
- 2013/2014* We were 39 members on July 1st, 2013; 2 new joined the club, 1 left. Today we are 40. We know that the capacity of a club to serve the community, support the Rotary Foundation and form leaders able to serve Rotary, at district or international levels, depends on the number and on the fellowship between its members.
- 2012/2013* It is necessary to implement our activity under this aspect.
It was a difficult year for many members who demonstrated, for various reasons (increase in difficulties at work, economic and/or personal problems, family members.....) they will to put the Club in second place in their priorities.
8 members resigned (a few were asked to resign); one new member joined. Of the ones who left, one asked to become a PAF, to be able, in the short term, to request readmission to the club.
This was the second year running of large net decreases.
At 1/7/2013 the members are 39.

- 2011/2012 During this year there was an increase of 3 members and a decrease of 5 due to work and personal reasons. One member transferred to another club, one requested a transfer to PAF (Piattaforma degli Amici del Fiera) and two were gently asked to leave for non payment of the fees.
Now, at 1/7/2012, the member are 46.
One honorary member entered: now they are two.
- 2009/2011
- a) **Conservation:** reinforcement of friendship among members; involvement of the members in the club activity; continuous information on the club projects; interesting speakers to increase the attendance; cultural and enogastronomie visits/tours involving members, families and friends.
 - b) **Increase:** recommendations and guide lines on the strategy to be adopted with families, friends, work colleagues, community persons, well qualified professional people; up to date of member classifications.
 - c) **Formation:** tutoring activity for new members; continuing Rotary information at any level (Club, RI, TRF); participation to district events

Public Relations

- 2017/2018 On the public image front, the Club has concentrated its efforts on three main axes:
1. Valuing one's Facebook page with over 9,000 followers;
 2. Administering the Instagram profile of the Club which has about 2,000 followers.
 3. Promoting the project of Club Libri in Libertà, both with the use of the dedicated Facebook page, which has reached about 1,000 followers acquired exclusively through word of mouth among the Rotarian members, and through the organization of days dedicated to "liberation" of books in the main squares of the city of Milan. Thanks to these initiatives, the project has aroused appreciation and received donations from individuals, Rotarian friends and the Hoepli publishing house for about 250 books. The Libri in Libertà project was selected to be included among those that framed the District Congress on April 14 and 15.
- 2016/2017 The Club, on the front of the public image, concentrated its efforts on 2 main axes:
1. Preserving social media, in particular by enhancing its Facebook page that has over 9,000 followers;
 2. Promotion of Club Tip: "Books in Freedom". On this project, the club has developed a video that tells the initiative and allows its easy promotion on social media. At the same time a press campaign was launched that allowed him to tell it on several headlines. Among those who have resumed the initiative is La Repubblica that, on its portal, has not only reported the initiative but has also relaunched the video. Finally, a Facebook page of the club was opened, which currently has almost 1,000 followers. Alongside these activities, a review of the club's image was carried out with the implementation of new banner and sails used for interclubs and off-site meetings. This review was not only graphic but also conceptual as it wanted to highlight three key elements of the new vision of the Club.
 1. The national and international projection of RC Milano Fiera
 2. The centrality of serving for the life of the Club
 3. The Innovative Approach to Rotary Life and Mission
- 2015/2016 We continued to use Facebook and now also WhatsApp is utilized by the members of the club.
- 2014/2015 The commission performed its activity exclusively using facebook entering in contact with about 1,100 clubs in the world.

- 2013/2014 The commission performed its activity using the social network Facebook. The constant information activity, the daily exchange of news, gave us a good visibility. An example of this has been the meeting dedicated to the art work of the students of Brera artistic institute; we registered 771 clicks. The visions of the paintings, thanks to a sponsor, reached about 10,000 clicks. Among those who clicks "I like it" we noted the presence of person of particular interest, well known entrepreneur, members of important clubs, journalists, etc..... Certainly the best result is obtained with projects which capture the public interest; we awakened a particular interest with our project "new poverty" for new indigent families
- 2012/2013 The principle activity was the support of the most complicated project ever taken on by the Club. It is, in fact, an inter district project, which involved 10 RC's and in which we were in charge. Therefore we tried to obtain as much publicity as possible in the national and local press and on nation-wide television (TG2 in prime evening space) and on regional television. The main reason for this was to sow the seeds of a more attractive image of Rotary towards civil society, which very often, shows Rotarians in a completely different vest than the spirit of Service which, in reality holds us together.
- 2011/2012 The work performed took the form of the publication of some club news in the District magazine the opening of a profile in Facebook and working in the group Milan 2 team which is coordinated by the President of RC Milano San Siro and by the A.G. Luciano Zuffi
- 2009/2011 Reported the Rotary's principles and the club's activities outside the club with the intent to create interest of new potential members

Administration

- 2014/2018 The administration commission organized the ordinary and extraordinary programs, the calendar of the club's meetings, helping the secretary in his jobs and performing all the administrative activity connected with the management of the club. On February 2017 the Constitution and the Bylaws have been updated as per Col 2016
- 2013/2014 The Constitution and the Bylaws have been updated as per Col 2013; all members have been informed of all the changes to the procedures that regulate the activity of our association. Duly organized the weekly meetings; published the weekly bulletin; duly updated the insertions of the members in Ge.Ro and on rotary.org; maintained updated the web-site; duly assisted the secretary, treasurer and sergent-at-arm in their duties; collaboration with all the other club's committees
- 2012/2013 The committee's job was to organise the day to day administration of the club.
- 2011/2012 The committee's job was to organise the weekly meetings, the promotion of District events, the following of administrative problems, the publication of the club's newsletter, updating of the club's website and promotion of its use
- 2009/2011 Updating of the bylaws of the club; organization of the weekly meeting; promotion of the district events; performing the administrative duties *vis-a-vis* the district/RI/TRF; preparation of the club's bulletin; updating of the club's website and instruction on its use; preparation of the budget, monitoring the accounts and final balance sheet

Service Projects

2017/2018

In the 2017-2018 Rotary year, our club has pursued 17 projects, a large number, which has allowed the involvement of various (even if not all) members. Some projects were shared between the commission of the same name and other commissions, such as the "Youth Exchange" the "Ryla", "Rotaract Support". Other projects have been carried out for years, thanks to the initial spark of individual members, such as "Uganda distance support", "Marinella Award". Others have continued for years with contributions to Rotary-related organizations, such as "Amici del Cam", "Vision + Onlus". Others have had a beginning in the past year in cooperation and initiative of other clubs or directly of the District, as "A Tree for Rotarians", "Asili sicuri - Ospedale Buzzi". Another project, "Libri in Libertà", has had a further successful continuation even in this past Rotary year. We have been protagonists on two international projects with the granting of Global Grant: "Supply of school desks in India", started by an Indian RC and which has been going on successfully for some years thanks to the initiative of one of our partners in particular. For the second international project, "IT support to the scholasticate missionary in Kinshasa" instead the Global Grant has been rejected by Evanston for now, but has indicated the way to resubmit the project with some changes, which involves the greater involvement of the local community and of the Rotary Club of Kinshasa Matonge; this project has passed into the hands of the Rotarian team next

2016/2017

Of the 12 projects scheduled at the beginning of the year, 9 were completed (annual youth exchange, RYLA, Rotaract support, books in freedom, Marinella scholarship, assistance to CAM, sustainment of scholarship in Uganda, tutoring of new young business men, Vision+ support) 15 members working on. Book in freedom project has been sustained by 6 Rotary Clubs, 2 Rotaract and a third party organization "Urbano L'H@b". Project was reported in some newspapers/magazines. The first 50 book were "freed" in July. We point out that the "Premio Marinella" assigned on October 12, 2016, has been now re-examined for the next year. Kinshasa project will be completed in the next year with the help of the twin RC Besançon, (4 members involved). A new project "Science Media Center" has been started (5 members involved) granting assistance to the association "Tempesta di Cervelli" to realize a center of scientific divulgation at national level.

2015/2016

We worked on projects which have now been running for a number of years:

- ✚ Vision+onlus – active participation in its management (the club is a member)
- ✚ Amici del CAM – financial and operational participation of a member and his wife
- ✚ School and "bullying" – initiative to recover boys diverted for various reasons, financial assistance
- ✚ Supplied equipment to the recently constituted faculty of the Medical University of Istanbul with the assistance of TRF (closing of Global Grant started in 2014/2015)
- ✚ Adoptions in Uganda – 9 children followed by us for over 10 years and on new projects:
- ✚ Mondohonline - professional network of consultants aimed at the online integration of disabled persons and the realization projects useful for the community; obtained a District grant
- ✚ Opera di s. Antonio – financial assistance for the refurbishing of a dormitory for the homeless

- ✚ Theco Onlus in Costa Rica – contribution for the construction of living quarters in wood in remote areas
 - ✚ A.I.D.D. – financial assistance
- 2014/2015 As normally, we operated in the community's interest, participating in the projects "Scholarship SLA", to the activities of "Vision + onlus" and "Amici del CAM"; we renovated two statues of Brera, supplied some equipment inside the oxygen therapy project Optiflow (better described under TRF commission) and we took part in the project "bullying" initiative to recover boys diverted for different reasons.
- This project - performed together with RC Milano Duomo - was a very important activity in which prisoners who, talking about their suffering due to their orally and socially inappropriate behavior, presented their reality to the students of Milano schools.
- In the international field we continued with the adoptions in Uganda, performed a restoration project in Besançon (inside the twinning) and supplied some equipment to the neonatal faculty of medicine of University of Istanbul with the help of the TRF (Global Grant).
- 2013/2014 We operated in various directions: in our community particular emphasis was given to the project "new poverty" performed together with the Milano municipality.
- Lively participation in other projects namely "SLA scholarship", "Vision+", the support to "Amici del CAM" and to "Guglie del Duomo".
- In the international field we maintained the adoptions in Uganda.
- 2012/2013
- a) at local level:**
1. Restoration, after the land slide, of the Palazzo Ducale at Mantova together with students of the school Liceo Artistico Brera
This was the most important project of the year which involved not only the office of the Beni Artistici di Mantova but also the students of the Liceo Artistico Brera of Milano (who performed a day of examination of the site and five days of restoration). In addition 6 students of the school Liceo Victor Hugo di Besançon together with their teacher stayed 4 days in Mantova.
The project, which was performed with the help of 9 Mantova Rotary Clubs and the twin club of Besançon, received a lot of nation wide and local publicity, was supported by a District Simplified Grant.
 2. Bassini Hospital
We were informed by the Gianluca Strada Onlus that this hospital needed certain equipment for the urology andrology dept. With the assistance of our doctor members we helped to obtain the equipment for which we offered part payment to the hospital.
 3. Prizes for graduation thesis's on SLA
For the second consecutive year we participated in the giving of 10 prizes among 22 thesis's presented on SLA The thesis's were read and valuated by Elena Galassini. The prizes were distributed at a gala evening on 28/5/2013 at the Hotel Barone De Sassi di Sesto San Giovanni organized by RC Sesto Milenium Centenario with the help of our club, the Associazione italiana SLA and RC Merate Brianza. The above entities sponsored the event together with DSM Fisioterapia, Fondazione Stefano Borgonovo, Elsevier Srl and Interlem SpA.
- b) at international level**
- The club decided to not use its reduced resources, for this year, at an international level

- 2011/2012
- a) **at local level:** participation in district association “ Premio Rotary alla Professionalità” with financial assistance and operative terms to the Lecco event; initiative in favour of Rotarian Blood Donors Association for the preparation of a multi medial presentation to be used in meetings with other clubs and entities to collect funds for the purchase of a Mobile Unit for the collection blood at a cost of 150.000 €; increase in understanding of the work of “Opera di San Francesco” and we assisted them by the donation of 100 kg of “grana padano” purchased from a cooperative damaged in the earthquakes in Emilia; together with other clubs and entities we have financed 7 theses on the subject of SLA;
 - b) **at international level:** computing assistance to the Kinshasa computer school, in this last year of this project we purchased about a dozen PC at the local level which were installed by an electronic technician sent by us from Milan who also instructed the local technicians; we together with D3040 supplied 900 school benches to India (Madya Pradesh Region); long distance adoption of 8 children in Uganda; participation in the activities of the association “Cecità evitabile” by sending a large number of reading glasses to Kinshasa, we have also been in touch with the Italia-Uganda Association to supply them with reading glasses for the many Uganda students who need them.
- 2009/2011
- a) **at local level:** obtained a DSG in favour of “Gli amici del CAM”; participation to the activities of the association “Cecità evitabile onlus”; voluntary service performed by some members in favour of “AEVAL Onlus” (assistance to elder people);
 - b) **at international level:** computing assistance to the Kinshasa computer school (using a DSG on 2009/10); literacy and health in India (D3040) with the supply of school benches, toilets and clean water in different towns/villages; long distance adoption of 10 children in Uganda; twinning with RC Besançon.

Rotary Foundation

- 2017/2018
- The Foundation commission was strongly committed to working closely with the project commission for the Global Grant on Kinskasa, which unfortunately has some serious delays, but rather for participation as an international sponsor in a Global Grant in India (Madhya Pradesh - D 2040RI) in favor of a large number of schools (supply of school desks and courses for teachers). We proceeded to devolve the suggestions of the TRF to the annual fund (EREY), the permanent fund and the Polioplus fund.
- 2016/2017
- We donated the recommended annual amount (EREY) to the annual fund and to Polioplus fund. We applied for two global grants of which one was accepted (in favour of indian schools- D2040)
- 2015/2016
- We donated the recommended annual amount (EREY) to the annual fund and and to Polioplus fund. We applied for two district grants of which one was accepted
- 2014/2015
- Knowing the importance of the TRF activity we donated the recommended annual amount (EREY) to the annual fund and to Polioplus fund. We asked for two district grants one of which was accepted. It was connected with the project oxygen therapy "OPTIFLOW", the donation of 2 respiration machines to Niguarda hospital in Milano. Furthermore, as "international partner" we participated in a Global Grant performed by Rotary Club Istanbul-Erenkoy: 3 equipments in favor of new born babies with serious diseases hospitalized at the prenatal medical University of Istanbul

- 2013/2014 Knowing the importance of the activity of the Rotary Foundation, we devolved the suggested amount to the program funds and to PolioPlus funds. This year we did not request any district and global grant.
- 2012/2013
- a) We obtained 2 DSG's for our activities in favor of the Amici del CAM and for the Mantova project;
 - b) We updated our members on the activities of the Rotary Foundation;
 - c) We participated in the district initiatives in favour of Polio Plus by taking part in the RC Milano Cordusio project "Cioccalatini" for which the net proceeds were paid over by this club to PolioPlus; We also took part in the District project by selling 10 bracelets in the form of a droplet and the proceeds of these sales were paid to TRF through the District.
- 2011/2012 Realized 2 MGs for the supply of school benches to India and obtained a DSG to finance the activity of the "Amici del CAM"; updated our Members on the activities of TRF and how its mechanisms function. The total club's contributions to TRF (from the beginning up to 30/6/2012) amount to \$ 195.173,35
- 2009/2011 More information to the members about the TRF activities and how to use its programs and finance; participation to a DSG; contribution to the Annual (program) Fund and PolipPlus/EndPolioNow campaign.
- 1995/2009 The Club participates in various programs of TRF from the beginning, living hospitality to GSE members, taking part in Matching Grants and lately in DSG, offering contributions to the Annual Fund, Permanent Fund and PolioPlus (EndPolioNow).

New Generation

- 2017/2018 RYLA: in the district course we enrolled 1 boy reported by Rotaract Sforza. Support for the Rotaract Club Milano Sforza: like every year we followed him in his activity giving him the necessary financial support. From the point of view of the services, we participated in the project "the Gardens of Rotaract" and our members took part in the graffiti cleaning initiative. Rotaract Sforza participated in the "Books in freedom" initiative and was one of the first clubs to adhere to bookcrossing.
- 2016/2017 Young Annual Exchange: We continued tutoring Georgia's Molly Kowald eighteen, coming from Katanning (Australia), who arrived in Italy in January 2016 and returned home in January 2017. She attended the ITS Feltrinelli with good results. In September 2016, we received Vass Klara Linnea, a sixteen-year-old girl from Hammaro (Sweden), who attended the Liceo Artistico Boccioni in Milan and returned home at the end of June 2017 - With both girls we had contacts and meetings with Italian host families, verifying the progress of relationships and hospitality.
- RYLA: At the district course we enrolled 2 girls who in March came to report to our club.
 - Rotaract Club Milano Sforza: Like every year we have followed it in its activity giving it the necessary operational / financial support
- 2015/2016 Summer camp: we assisted in the management of Milan summer camp which took place during the first fifteen days of July 2015.
Rotaract Club Milano Sforza: as usual we followed their activity helping them operationally whenever necessary.
- 2014/2015
- a) Youth exchange: we matched an exchange of 1 Italian boy to the USA and 1 Brazilian girl hosted by us in Milano.
 - b) Summer Camp in Milano: we help to organize the summer camp Milano (it will take place in the first 15 days of July 2015)

- c) Rotaract Club Milano Sforza: we followed its evolution and joined its activity in some projects
 To the original patrons (we and RC Milano Villoresi) 2 new club joined us: RC Milano Cordusio and RC Milano International
- 2013/2014 Full assistance to our Rotaract club Milano Sforza whose members have participated, together with "telefono azzurro association", to a project assisting child, with parents in jail, during their visit to them.
 Sponsored an annual exchange between an Italian girl who went to USA and an American one arrived from Pennsylvania; grant a scholarship to a new graduate inside our "Premio Marinella"; painting competition at the Brera artistic institute donating the collected amount to a nursery school destroyed during the earthquake in Emilia and actually staying in containers.
- 2012/2013
- a) Closely followed the activities of the Rotaract Club Milano Sforza with the assistance of RC Milano Villoresi (co-patron from the foundation of RTC) and RC Milano Cordusio and RC Milano International (co-patrons of last year). Among other initiatives the children produced a comedy of which the proceeds went to 3 projects of the clubs which form gruppo Milano 2.
 - b) This year instead of sending participants to RYLA we utilised the RYGHT seminar, set up in our district for the first time, and open to children from 14 to 18 year olds; we sent the children of two of our members to this three day seminar on "Peace through service."
 - c) As we have always done for the last few years we sponsored the realisation, with the assistance of the untiring Mario Rozza, of a short film produced by a class of the "Liceo Artistico Brera" for the "Premio Gavioli.
 - d) Again this year we made a contribution to CAM by way of a DSG.
 - e) We also as usual, granted a scholarship to a student under our "Premio Marinella"
- 2011/2012 Followed closely the activities of the Rotaract Club Milano Sforza with the assistance of RC Milano Villoresi (co-patron) and RC Milano Cordusio (new co-patron) while RC Milano International has asked us to collaborate in the future; for the school year 2011/2012 we sponsored an American student and sent an Italian student to the States; sponsored a candidate to RYLA; sponsored the realisation of a short film realized by a class of the "Liceo Artistico Brera" under "Premio Gavioli"; we made a contribution to CAM by way of a DSG; Also this year we granted a scholarship to one student in physics under our "Premio Marinella".
- 2009/2011 Set up the *Rotaract Club Milano Sforza* with the contribution of 8 boys/ girls, children of some our members, and the co-sponsoring of RC Milano Villoresi; operative activity and economic contribution to the "premio maturità" of Rotaract; organization of the XI summer camp in Milano; sponsored a candidate to RYLA; hospitality and economic contribution to a young foreign student during his long term exchange in Milano (on 2009-10); delivered two grants "Premio Marinella" at two neo degrees in physics.
- 2008/2009 Hospitality in Milano to the American GSE group
- 2007/2009 Youth exchange: summer camp organized in Milano inviting 12 boys/girls.

Twinning

- 2017/2018 In the last year the Twinning Commission obtained the participation of the French Club at the Global Grant (still under definition) for the Kinshasa school (supply of computers, program updates, local WiFi care, maintenance of drinking water wells at the service of the school). The amount made available by the Club of Besançon amounts to 5000 euros. In April, a delegation from our Club went to Besançon for the annual meeting. Interesting days that have established the friendship of three clubs: the Besançon, the Neuchatel and the Milano Fiera
- 2016/2017 This year we went to visit our Twin Club in Besançon.
We expected the appointment of their incoming president to meet and define a common project to be shared for 2017/18. Our proposal for Kinshasa was unanimously accepted by their board of directors. Brigitte and her co-members welcomed us with the extraordinary sympathy of all time, accompanying us in tourist-cultural-games-tours. There was a unified Council where the French unanimously agreed to accept our proposal to subsidize the Kinshasa project. We have promised that there will be a meeting to finalize the project to explain the work done and the results obtained.
The 8 year twinning always goes on well with the usual enthusiasm of all parties.
- 2015/2016 This year, our twinned club, RC Besançon, very well represented (53 divided between members and family) visited us from 18 to 20 September, for our French friends we programmed visits to EXPO on the afternoon of the 18th and all day on the 19th September, to finish with a gala dinner at Palazzo Cusani on September 20. Before leaving we took them on a visit to the Duomo
- 2014/2015 This year our club visited the twinning club in connection with the presentation of the painting, of Italian origin at Besançon Cathedral, restored by the 2 clubs. This is one of the two projects scheduled for the 2014/15 year.
The second one was in Burkina Faso where we took part financing some local activities followed personally by mr. Jean François Guyonneau, member of the RC Besançon.
- 2013/2014 Many exchanges of courtesy between our club and RC Besançon but no youth exchanges take during the current year. Youth exchanges will take place on the next year between families (and not through schools) and the age of the participants cannot be more than 17 years.
We will take part in the Burghina Faso project proposed by RC Besançon and to the restoration of a religious painting of the Italian school, exhibited in the Besançon cathedral. The painting is by Baldi, an Italian artist. An important fact, the painting can be lent to Italian museums, with the authorisation of our twinned clubs.
- 2012/2013 We exchanged young students with RC Besançon. Six students of “liceo scientifico Vittorio Veneto” Milano stayed for 4 days in May 2012 with Rotary families in Besançon and the same number of students from “liceo Victor Hugo” Besançon with their teacher stayed for 4 days in May in *Mantova, Sabbonetta and Venice*.
- 2011/2012 We exchanged young students with RC Besançon. Six students of “liceo scientifico Vittorio Veneto” Milano for a stayed for a week in October 2011 with Rotary families in Besançon and for a week in the month of February 2012 six students from “liceo Victor Hugo” Besançon with the headmistress and another teacher stayed in Milan and were given a very intensive program of visits to monuments, two mornings at school, etc. We plan to repeat this experiment in Rotarian year 2012/2013; In June we were present at the 80th

anniversary of their club; a few representatives of their club came to our ceremony of installation of the new President 2012/13

2009/2011

From 8th May 2010, the club is twinned with the RC Besançon. A specific “Twinning subcommittee” took care of the relationship with the members/leaders of the RC Besançon, examining future projects to be done in synergy. A students exchange has been scheduled for the 2011-2012
